<u>Area A1: The Written Word</u>: Courses from this list teach you the skills to organize and express your ideas and thoughts in the right compositional and grammatical manner. These are specific critical reading and writing skills that students need to succeed in their future coursework.

<u>Area A2: Calculations</u>: Courses from this list teach you to express your thoughts and ideas through mathematics and quantitative reasoning for comprehending the world in which we live.

<u>Area B: Perspectives</u>: Courses from this list teach you how to see the interrelatedness of our life experiences. These classes are focused on significant questions or issues not regularly explored elsewhere in the curriculum.

<u>Area C: Creations and Speculations</u>: Courses from this list demonstrate how we interpret our humanity and how we express those understandings in our own original ways.
