Georgia History: Have you taken and passed a United States History survey course (either "to 1865/77" or "since 1865/77") in college, in the state of Georgia?

YES* → You <u>DO NOT</u> need to take the Georgia History Exemption Exam

NO \rightarrow You \overrightarrow{DO} need to take the Georgia History Exemption Exam
