





Total Enrollment by Residency, Fall 2017




Total Enrollment of Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2017




Graduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender, Fall 2017




Graduate Enrollment by Primary College, Fall 2017



Graduate Students by 5 Largest Primary Majors, Fall 2017




Undergraduate Enrollment by Class, Fall 2017

Undergraduate Enrollment by Primary College, Fall 2017





First-Time Freshmen by 5 Largest Declared Primary Majors, Fall 2017








First-Time Freshmen Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2017




First-Time Freshmen Enrollment of Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2017











Undergraduate Adult Learners Enrollment by Primary College, Fall 2017








Total Enrollment for Distance Learning, Fall 2017
