



Total Enrollment by Gender and Ethnicity, Fall 2019





Total Enrollment by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall





Total Enrollment by College, Fall 2019



Total Enrollment by Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment and Gender, Fall 2019




Total Enrollment by Residency, Fall 2019






Undergraduate Enrollment by College, Fall 2019





Undergraduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender, Fall 2019





Undergraduate Enrollment by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2019




Graduate Enrollment, Fall 2015-19



Graduate Enrollment by College, Fall 2019




Graduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender, Fall 2019


Graduate Enrollment by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2019










First-Time Freshmen by 5 Largest Declared Primary Majors, Fall 2019




First-Time Freshmen Enrollment by Primary College, Fall 2019
