





Total Enrollment by Residency, Spring 2017




Total Enrollment of Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment by Gender, Spring 2017






Undergraduate Enrollment, Spring 2013—Spring 2017




Undergraduate Students by College, Spring 2017





Graduate Enrollment by College, Spring 2017




Undergraduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender,




Undergraduate Students by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Spring 2017



Graduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender, Spring 2017




Graduate Students by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Spring 2017




Undergraduate Adult Learners by Classification and Gender, Spring 2017




Undergraduate Adult Learners by College, Spring 2017




Undergraduate Adult Learners by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Spring 2017




Total Enrollment for Distance Learning, Spring 2017
