

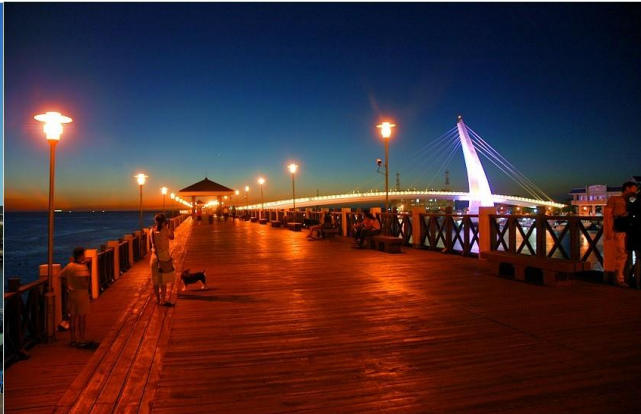
Sightseeing and Excursion in Taiwan and Hong Kong
