

Department of Art Freshman/TransferStudent Scholarship Application Details 2015-2016

Amount:

Up to full tuition to be given for one academic year. Eligibility will be reviewed each semester.

Criteria*:

- 1. The candidate must present SAT scores, a high school or college transcript that indicates a cumulative B average, and be in good standing with that institution.
- 2. The candidate must provide the selection committee with three letters of recommendation, at least one from an art teacher.
- 3. The candidate must be available for an interview by VSU Art Faculty, and present a portfolio of work that includes a minimum of five and a maximum of eight examples of their artwork. Slides, digital images or physical portfolios will be accepted. Slides and digital images must be properly labeled and must be accompanied by a corresponding slide identification sheet. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope for return of submitted material. *Qualified applicants will be advised concerning dates for possible interviews and portfolio reviews.*
- 4. Application for admission to Valdosta State University is a condition for scholarship consideration and should be made as early as possible. Scholarship recipients must declare Art as their major, and be enrolled at VSU full time, with a minimum of one major curriculum class per semester.

*Other criteria may apply.

Entry Deadline:

All application materials are to be received by the Valdosta State University Department of Art no later than Monday, March 30, 2015. Portfolios will be ready for return April 10, 2015.
