**Note:** This program is 132/3 hours; A student must average between 16 and 18 hours each semester in order to graduate within a four-year period or take 6 hours over two or three summer school sessions. CORE and Education courses can be taken during the summer sessions, however, ART, ARTH, and ARED courses are typically offered during the academic year only.

Students who are required to take the **GACE** (Georgia Assessment for the Certification of Educators) **GACE Program Admissions Assessment** should take it prior to, or during ARED 2999. **GACE Program Admissions Assessment** must be passed to enter the Senior Curriculum sequence. Students are required to take the **GACE Content Assessment** prior to the Student Teaching semester. **Certification depends on passing the GACE Content Assessment.**

A minimum grade point average of **2.75** must be maintained throughout the program. A grade of “C” or better must be earned in the required English courses and in all ART, ARED and EDUC courses in the professional sequence.
