- ✓ Students will (1) submit an Application for Admission to OAT-OBC, (2) complete Area A-F requirements, (3) demonstrate online readiness, and (4) validate a minimum of three years' experiential credit (ACED 2940) before being fully admitted to the OAT-OBC option.
- ✓ Once fully admitted, OAT-OBC majors will be allowed priority registration for online ACED major courses according to the OAT-OBC Master Schedule Rotation.
- ✓ OAT- OBC majors may take NO MORE than 30 hours of coursework from the College of Business.
- ✓ OAT-OBC majors must have an overall minimum 2.3 GPA before enrolling in the following ACED courses: ACED 4020, 4050, 4070, and 4160.
- ✓ Students will submit an ePortfolio to their OAT-OBC Advisor for assessment before the end of their final semester.
- ✓ Per VSU requirements, students must make a C or better in all courses listed in Area F and under MAJOR COURSE REQUIREMENTS (including Guided Electives).
