## **Performance-Based Leadership Cognate Requirements**

- 1. Prior to conducting performance-based activities, a student must meet the Georgia PSC pre-service requirement for performance-based leadership preparation by holding a clear/renewable Leadership (L) certificate at the master's level or higher or meet one of the following criteria: hold a master's degree in Educational Leadership or complete EDUC 9000, Interdisciplinary Studies in Education (with the appropriate content modules) and LEAD 9010, Instructional Leadership for School Administrators. These courses include the equivalent PSC required content. Topics addressed in these courses include school law and ethics, organizational leadership, teaching and learning, and using data for school improvement. Courses with performance-based activities are LEAD 8920, 8930, 8940, 9020, & 9040.
- 2. The student must be employed in a leadership role or position as defined by the local system and submit a signed Superintendent's Assurance Form.
- 3. Students must successfully complete EDUC 5999, Professional Orientation (0 credit hours) during the first semester of residency (LEAD 8920).
- 4. An Advanced Inventory of Leadership Experiences must be successfully completed.
- 5. All COE LiveText forms including candidate information, dispositions survey (pre and post), and field experiences must be completed.
- 6. A GACE Leadership (test #173 & 174) score must be recorded--a passing score is required for Performance-Based Leadership certification and certificate upgrade (PL6/7) but not graduation.
- 7. All courses as outlined on the program of study must be completed.
- 8. All graduation requirements as specified in the Graduate Catalog must be met.
