3. A 300 to 500 word abstract of your proposal.
4. A 50 to 75 word summary of your proposal (for inclusion in the proceedings)
5. For submission of a symposium, please submit separate 300 to 500 word abstracts and 50 to 75 word summaries of for each presentation making up the symposium. A general summary of the entire symposium should be included.
6. Workshop submissions should include a statement of learning goals for participants.

Review will begin as submissions are received.

Presentation and symposia submissions are due March 20, 2017.

Poster and workshop submissions are due March 25, 2017.
