RESOLUTION #15-05 GEORGIA AVENUE – REPURSPOSE AND REEVALUTION PARKING LOTS

Be it enacted by the Senate of Valdosta State University (VSU) here assembled, that:

WHEREAS, as a collective student body have decided that parking spaces on Georgia Avenue which are next to the Health Clinic are not being used properly,

WHEREAS, we have seen that the parking spaces could be allocated to the use of commuter students and residential to decrease the number of incidents and promote campus safety,

WHEREAS, a parking space is defined as a space in which a car occupies, and a parking lot is defined as an area of cleared land purposed for spaces,

WHEREAS, all of the lots surrounding Georgia Avenue are currently occupied by employees of VSU, and due to there being more parking spaces than employees the student body feels at least one (1) lot is recommended to be repurposed into either a commuter or residential student lot, and the remaining lots are to be allotted to the faculty and staff.

WHEREAS, this will promote student convenience and allow students to attend classes as scheduled, while allowing employees of VSU to properly attend to their work. This is to allow academic excellence to improve while increasing student accessibility to be maintained and promote easier points of access to the areas surrounding Bailey Science Center like Reade Hall, Georgia Hall and Career Opportunities,

WHEREAS, adherence to the Student Government Association (SGA) strategic plan has exposed Senators to additional student feedback and suggestions for improvement and seen reason that there has been one such lot mentioned above in years past. To be specific this time period is in reference was before the construction of the Health Clinic building which once was completed did not replace the lot it had built over.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT upon passage by Student Government Association of Valdosta State University, this resolution will carry the support of the student body of VSU,

FINALLY, LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT the Student Government Association recommends Parking and Transportation of Valdosta State University to reevaluate and repurpose parking spaces along Georgia Avenue when the Senior Leadership Team meets to allocate parking spaces.
