The Masters of Public Administration at Valdosta State University is an entirely online program consisting of 36 credit hours, typically completed in two years. Students can choose from three concentrations: Human Resource Management, Public Sector Management, and Public Policy. This program is part of the political science department. Tuition is \$300 per credit hour for all students, regardless of residency, and there is a \$60 technology fee each semester. A limited number of assistantships are available for students living in or near Valdosta, as remote assistantships are not offered.
