Do I have to apply to VSU to take PACE classes? How do I register?

No. All of our classes are open to the public. We have 3 ways to register: online, by phone, and in person.

Can my minor child take adult PACE classes?

Due to Minors on Campus policies, children under 18 may not participate in online or in-person adult PACE classes.

What about masks?
